3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Parity Implementation
- 5 Assistance Act".

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SEC. 2. GRANTS TO SUPPORT MENTAL HEALTH AND SUB STANCE USE DISORDER PARITY IMPLEMEN TATION.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2794(c) of the Public
5 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300gg–94(c)) (as added by
6 section 1003 of the Patient Protection and Affordable
7 Care Act (Public Law 111–148) is amended by adding at
8 the end the following:

9 "(3) PARITY IMPLEMENTATION.—

10 "(A) IN GENERAL.—Beginning 60 days 11 after the date of enactment of the Parity Imple-12 mentation Assistance Act, the Secretary shall 13 award grants to States to implement the mental 14 health and substance use disorder parity provi-15 sions of section 2726, provided that in order to 16 receive such a grant, a State is required to re-17 quest and review from health insurance issuers 18 offering group or individual health insurance 19 coverage the comparative analyses and other in-20 formation required of such health insurance 21 issuers under subsection (a)(8)(A) of such sec-22 tion 2726 regarding the design and application 23 of nonquantitative treatment limitations im-24 posed on mental health or substance use dis-25 order benefits.

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"(B) AUTHORIZATION 1 \mathbf{OF} APPROPRIA-2 TIONS.—For purposes of awarding grants 3 under subparagraph (A), there are authorized 4 to be appropriated \$25,000,000 for each of the first five fiscal years beginning after the date of 5 6 the enactment of this paragraph.". (b) TECHNICAL AMENDMENT.—Section 2794 of the 7 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300gg-95), as 8 added by section 6603 of the Patient Protection and Af-9

10 fordable Care Act (Public Law 111–148) is redesignated11 as section 2795.
