3	(a) Firearms Dispositions.—Section 922(b)(3)(A)
4	of title 18, United States Code, is amended—
5	(1) by striking "rifle or shotgun" and inserting
6	"firearm";
7	(2) by striking "located" and inserting "located
8	or temporarily located"; and
9	(3) by striking "both such States" and insert-
10	ing "the State in which the transfer is conducted

13	duty, or a spouse of the member, is a resident of—
14	"(A) the State in which the person main-
15	tains legal residence;
16	"(B) the State in which the permanent
17	duty station of the member is located; and
18	"(C) the State in which the member main-
19	tains a place of abode from which the member
20	commutes each day to the permanent duty sta-
21	tion.
22	"(2) An officer or employee of the United
23	States (other than a member of the Armed Forces)
24	stationed outside the United States for a period ex-
