Securing Nearly \$793 Million for Major Flood Protection Projects Alone!

Senator Cassidy helped secure \$477 million for the **Morganza to the Gulf** hurricane and storm surge protection system through the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. This project is critical for **Terrebonne and Lafourche Parishes**, reducing flood risk, safeguarding homes and businesses, and strengthening coastal defenses.

He also delivered additional funding to the **Atchafalaya Basin** — \$316 million total — to support regional flood control, navigation, and sediment management benefiting **St. Mary and surrounding parishes**.

- Introduced the **Flood Insurance Affordability Tax Credit Act** – 33% credit for working families.
- Led a bill to **extend NFIP through 2026**.
- Pressed FEMA to **end Risk Rating 2.0** premium hikes.
- Advocated for continued **BRIC grants** to strengthen flood mitigation statewide.
