DELIVERING OVER **\$455 MILLION** FOR CENTRAL LOUISIANA!

Senator Cassidy helped deliver **\$219.8 million** to expand Syrah Resources' graphite processing facility in Vidalia, creating more jobs and supporting the Central Louisiana economy.

Cassidy also secured **\$30 million** for Fort Polk to build new housing for soldiers rotating through the Joint Readiness Training Center, providing updated living quarters for tens of thousands of service members training there each year.
