## DELIVERING **\$1.5 BILLION** FOR THE CAPITAL REGION!

**Senator Cassidy delivered \$471 million to fully fund and complete the Comite River Diversion Canal**, a critical and long-awaited flood control project that will divert floodwaters from the Comite River to the Mississippi River, providing protection for families and businesses across the Capital Region.

**Cassidy also secured \$225 million for the East Baton Rouge Flood Control Project**, a major drainage improvement initiative to clear and widen channels across five key sub-basins, significantly reducing flood risk and hardening infrastructure against future storms.

### **Making Flood Insurance Affordable Again!**

Senator Cassidy is leading the charge to **make flood insurance affordable again** and ensure the **National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) remains sustainable**. Cassidy has:

- Introduced the **Flood Insurance Affordability Tax Credit Act** – 33% credit for working families.
- Led a bill to **extend NFIP through 2026**.
- Pressed FEMA to **end Risk Rating 2.0** premium hikes.
- Advocated for continued **BRIC grants** to strengthen flood mitigation statewide.
