Senator Bill Cassidy helped secure major roadway upgrades across the Northshore — including the \$25 million I-12 widening project in St. Tammany Parish and the \$13.4 million LA-3241 Interchange — to reduce traffic, improve safety, and support regional growth.

Funding Roads, Bridges, Mental Health, Flood Protection, and More!

\$4.7 million – Elevating 26 flood-prone homes in Slidell

\$1 million – I-12 Interchange Lighting at US-51

\$675,000 – Comprehensive Mental Health / Substance Abuse Treatment Initiative (Covington)

Making Flood Insurance Affordable Again!

Senator Cassidy is leading the charge to **make flood insurance affordable again** and ensure the **National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) remains sustainable**. Cassidy has:

- Introduced the **Flood Insurance Affordability Tax Credit Act** – 33% credit for working families.
- Led a bill to **extend NFIP through 2026**.
- Pressed FEMA to **end Risk Rating 2.0** premium hikes.
- Advocated for continued **BRIC grants** to strengthen flood mitigation statewide.
