



# **BILL** U.S. Senator for Louisiana **CASSIDY, M.D.**

## **DELIVERING OVER \$932 MILLION FOR THE SOUTHSHORE!**

**Senator Cassidy delivered \$135 million to elevate and improve LA-1, the only highway connecting Port Fourchon and Grand Isle to the rest of Louisiana.** This project keeps one of the nation's most important energy and seafood corridors open during storms and high water, strengthens evacuation routes, and protects thousands of local jobs tied to the port and coastal economy.

**Cassidy also secured \$101.4 million to modernize New Orleans Regional Transit Authority service,** replacing aging buses and infrastructure while supporting construction of a new Downtown Transit Center and corridor upgrades, along with improvements to the Algiers Point Ferry Terminal. These investments improve reliability for daily riders and strengthen transit connections across the region.

### **Funding Roads, Bridges, Disaster Recovery, Flood Protection, and More!**

- \$84.5 million** – Louis Armstrong Airport connector road linking the new terminal to parking
  - \$71.4 million** – Modernizing New Orleans' transit fleet
  - \$52.7 million** – LA-47 / Industrial Canal bridge upgrades
  - \$27.3 million** – Rehabilitation of the Harvey Canal Tunnel
  - \$25 million** – Statewide ferry design and construction supporting Plaquemines Parish routes
  - \$24.83 million** – New Orleans Downtown Transit Center and corridor upgrades
  - \$20.48 million** – Reconstructing I-10 from Paris Road to Lake Pontchartrain
  - \$16.79 million** – Causeway Blvd–Earhart Expressway Phase 1A roadway improvements
  - \$15.27 million** – Louis Armstrong Airport airfield and safety upgrades (FY22)
  - \$15.01 million** – Louis Armstrong Airport improvements (FY23 allocation)
  - \$14.53 million** – Additional Louis Armstrong Airport airfield funding (FY22)
  - \$14.50 million** – Additional Louis Armstrong Airport funding (FY23)
  - \$13.50 million** – I-10 / Loyola Interchange modernization
  - \$8.76 million** – Replacement bridge for the Belle Chasse Tunnel (major phase)

### **Making Flood Insurance Affordable Again!**

Senator Cassidy is leading the charge to **make flood insurance affordable again** and ensure the **National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) remains sustainable.** Cassidy has:

- Introduced the **Flood Insurance Affordability Tax Credit Act** – 33% credit for working families.
- Led a bill to **extend NFIP through 2026.**
- Pressed FEMA to **end Risk Rating 2.0** premium hikes.
- Advocated for continued **BRIC grants** to strengthen flood mitigation statewide.
