A NOTE FROM SENATOR CASSIDY

As I travel across Louisiana, nearly every community has desperate infrastructure needs. Congress came together to put forward a historic investment in our nation's roads, bridges, waterways, and online infrastructure. The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) is the largest investment in infrastructure and coastal resiliency in the history of our state.

This law is a major victory for Louisiana and our nation. IIJA will rebuild our roads and bridges, increase access to high-speed internet, strengthen our electric grid, add levee protection, and improve flood resiliency. After almost every corner of our state was hit by natural disasters in recent years, we must have the federal investment to protect us from future storms.

The need to repair and update infrastructure is all around us. In 2017, the American Society of Civil Engineers Infrastructure Report Card gave Louisiana's infrastructure a failing grade of D+. Twelve percent of our bridges are in poor or worse condition. Commute times are up 9.3 percent since 2011, and bad roads result in an average cost to drivers of \$667 per year. Sixty-four community water systems received F grades and 66 systems earned D grades according to the Louisiana Department of Health's new grading system.

Nearly two years in, Louisiana has benefited tremendously from IIJA. As of July 2023, \$4.5 billion in funding from the law has been announced and is headed to Louisiana with over 245 specific projects identified for funding. Since IIJA passed,

approximately \$3.4 billion has been announced for transportation—to invest in roads, bridges, public transit, ports, and airports—and roughly \$258 million has been announced for clean water. And more than 447,000 households across the state are receiving affordable high-speed internet due to the IIJA.

We have received more than our fair share of funding because we had a seat at the table. Louisiana ranks in the top five states on a per capita basis for bridge grants; ranks seven among states for total Phase One funding for plugging orphaned wells; received the single largest award in the entire country at \$600 million to build a Direct Air Capture hub in Southwest Louisiana; and received 12.5 percent of the total first-round funding in Mega grant requests for the Calcasieu River Bridge to name a few.

I came to Washington to get a job done. That's what Louisiana sent me here to do. This law will shorten your commute time, lessen the chance of flooding in your home, create jobs, and extend broadband internet to schools, families, and businesses. It does all this in a fiscally responsible way.

You have to be in the room to push things in the right direction for Louisiana. That's what I've done and intend to continue doing for our state.

ABOUT THE INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT & JOBS ACT

The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) is exclusively focused on funding real, hard infrastructure. The law is \$550 billion of new infrastructure spending, combined with regular, baseline annual spending.

The majority of the funding reauthorizes surface transportation programs, which Congress needs to do every several years to maintain our nation's already crumbling and aging infrastructure. The new spending is used for investments to modernize and build infrastructure like roads, bridges, airports, broadband, water, electrical grids, and coastal resiliency.

The law is fully paid for in a responsible way. It does not raise taxes and will help generate billions in economic growth for decades to come. According to a Penn Wharton analysis, IIJA decreases the deficit and is a net benefit to the economy. The law is funded in part by using unspent unemployment insurance and unspent COVID-19 recovery funding.

Funding will be used to repair and rebuild roads, including over 3,352 miles of highway considered to be in "poor condition." LA has already been awarded \$3.62 billion for roadway safety and highway projects.

Funding is being used for bridge construction and repair. LA has nearly 1,571 bridges considered to be in "poor condition."



\$1.4B

Funding has already been awarded to help provide broadband services to the nearly 400,000 Louisianans who still don't have access.

Funding will be used to build and improve public transit systems in efforts to reduce traffic congestion and provide additional transportation options.

Highways, Bridges, Broadband & Airports



- In 2021, Louisiana received about \$768 million in federal highway formula dollars. Under IIJA, Louisiana has received \$2.7 billion to invest in roads, bridges, and other major highway projects. The law also created an \$8.7 billion program to help states improve resiliency of transportation infrastructure, evacuation routes, and at-risk coastal areas.
- \$40 billion investment in bridges across the country.
- <u>Authorizes I-14 Corridor</u> to run from Georgia to Texas, which will include stops in Leesville and Alexandria continuing through Natchez, Mississippi and Alabama up to Augusta, Georgia.
- <u>Permitting will be streamlined</u> to reduce paperwork and get projects done. <u>One Federal Decision</u> will reduce permit wait times to less than two years.
- \$7.5 billion for Rebuilding American Infrastructure with
 Sustainability and Equity Grants (RAISE Grants formerly
 known as BUILD Grants), which support transportation
 projects of local and regional significance up to \$25 million. It
 also provided \$8 billion in Infrastructure for Rebuilding America

- Grants (INFRA Grants), which support major highway and freight projects, an increase of \$3.5 billion over five years.
- \$100 million for asset recycling and technical assistance for public-private partnerships. This funding provides communities with resources to take advantage of private investment in infrastructure assets. Louisiana can also take advantage of TIFIA loans. These loans, provided by the Department of Transportation, assist communities developing road, transit, rail, and port projects, and under this legislation, funds will now be available for airport projects.
- \$65 billion in grants for broadband deployment.
- \$25 billion for airport improvement projects such as terminal expansions, assistance with planning, rebuilding runways, improving lighting, and funding air navigation facilities throughout the state.
 - \$20 billion is set <u>aside</u> for "airside projects"
 - Formula Funding: \$15 billion (\$3 billion per year) over five years for grants for airports to use for the Airport Improvement Program.
 - Discretionary Funding: \$5 billion (\$1 billion per year) over five years for the Airport Terminal Program. The program ensures terminal projects at small hub, non-hub, and non-primary airports receive funding.
- \$5 billion is set aside for FAA air traffic control infrastructure and facilities.







Leading in Energy

Louisiana is in a unique position to continue to lead in energy generation and carbon intensity reduction. IIJA positions Louisiana to take advantage of all current and future energy and industrial growth while being a lead exporter in energy and energy technologies.

- Of the \$17 billion for Army Corps work, \$9.55 billion for Ports and Waterways related Army Corp work will benefit numerous Louisiana Ports and Waterways including the Port of Calcasieu, Port Fourchon, Port of New Orleans, Port of Baton Rouge, Port of South Louisiana, Port of Plaquemines, and J. Bennett Johnston Waterway. There is also \$2.25 billion for the Port Infrastructure Development Program.
- \$8 billion for Hydrogen Hubs to promote the production, processing, delivery, storage, and end-use of hydrogen. This program is tailor-made for Louisiana's industry, existing infrastructure, and energy sector.
- \$5.1 billion investment in carbon capture, utilization, and storage (CCUS) technology. This financing will go towards developing CO2 pipelines and storage—a process in which

Louisiana leads the nation due to work being done by the private sector, like Gulf Coast Sequestration, and the state government to establish Class VI primacy in the state.

- \$3.5 billion for Direct Air Capture Hubs for Carbon Removal. This carves out a pathway for Louisiana to lead in carbon removal and decarbonization while maintaining and growing existing industries and infrastructure.
- IIJA includes <u>permitting of offshore energy storage</u> and geologic carbon sequestration, unlocking both on-land and off-shore resources for the state.
- \$9.04 billion for Demonstration Projects to support the development of key energy technologies including advanced nuclear reactors, carbon capture, critical minerals, energy storage, and industrial emissions infrastructure. The University of Louisiana at Lafayette received funding for a similar program.
- \$1 billion for the modernization of natural gas distribution pipelines for municipalities or community-owned utilities to repair, rehabilitate, or replace natural gas distribution pipeline systems.



Strengthening Weather Resiliency for Louisiana Citizens

IIJA makes major strides towards unleashing expanded financing for families, communities, and local businesses to protect themselves from severe weather. Louisiana citizens have benefited immensely from these programs in the past, and by providing never-before-seen levels of funding for further expansions of these programs, we can be sure Louisiana's citizens will be better protected.

- \$3.5 billion for Flood Mitigation Assistance grants. These grants are used for projects that reduce or eliminate the risk of repetitive flood damage to buildings insured by the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). In Fiscal Year 2020, one-third of applications for this program came from Louisiana.
- \$3.5 billion for the Department of Energy's Weatherization

 Assistance Program to reduce energy costs for low-income households by increasing the energy efficiency of their homes while ensuring their health and safety. The Louisiana Housing Corporation can help potential applicants determine eligibility and guide them through the application process.

- \$1 billion for Building Resilient Infrastructures and Communities (BRIC grants). These grants provide funding for pre-disaster mitigation of natural disasters, including flooding.
- \$492 million for NOAA National Coastal Resilience Fund. This funding will improve flood resiliency for coastal communities by restoring or expanding natural ecosystems. This also enhances fish and wildlife habitats while mitigating other coastal hazards.
- \$500 million for the STORM Act. This provides grants to establish a revolving fund for mitigation assistance to reduce risks from disasters and natural hazards. Funds provide assistance to local governments to carry out projects to reduce disaster risks for homeowners, businesses, nonprofit organizations, and communities. This is to decrease loss of life and property, the cost of insurance claims, and federal disaster payments.



Strengthening Coastal Protection and Restoration

- \$17 billion for Army Corps of Engineers infrastructure priorities. This includes \$2.55 billion for construction of Coastal Storm Risk Management and Hurricane and Storm Damage Reduction projects, specifically targeting states such as Louisiana that have been impacted by federally declared disasters over the last six years. Additional Louisiana projects that will benefit from these dollars include the Southwest Coastal Louisiana and Morganza to the Gulf Projects and \$350 million for Louisiana Corps Federal projects for dredging and emergency repair damages caused by Hurricanes Laura, Delta, and Zeta. There's \$808 million for Mississippi Rivers and Tributaries and \$251 million for Flood and Coastal Emergencies, which directly benefit Louisiana.
- \$53 million for Lake Pontchartrain. Lake Pontchartrain will receive this funding over five years to support local restoration efforts.
- \$491 million for National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Community Based Habitat Restoration Program. NOAA's Community-based Restoration Program provides funding for restoration projects that ensure fish have access to high-quality habitats. Projects range from improving access to habitats by removing dams and other barriers, to restoring coral and oyster reefs, to rebuilding coastal wetlands. This funding invests in

coastal resiliency projects through a habitat restoration program that helps protect the safety and well-being of coastal communities, like those in Louisiana, by buffering shorelines from erosion, reducing flooding, and removing potentially hazardous structures.

- \$492 million for NOAA Flood Mapping, Observations, and Modeling.
 This funding will update and improve mapping and modeling to get
 a better picture of the risk of flooding in Louisiana and throughout
 the country. Specific programs funded include the Coastal Mapping
 Program, nextGen National Water Modeling framework and others that
 depict the extent and depth of floods from actual and forecasted events.
- \$2.13 billion for Ecosystem Restoration and Resiliency Funding to restore the ecological health of federal lands and waters, and private lands. Working with state partners, like Louisiana, this funding will advance coastal restoration and flood mitigation efforts.
 - \$400 million is available for grants to states to implement voluntary ecosystem restoration projects on private or public land with a focus on cross-boundary projects (i.e. projects that cross across public and private land).
- \$53 million for EPA's Gulf of Mexico ecosystem restoration program.

 This protects and restores the water bodies and coastal environments associated with the greater Gulf of Mexico region.
- \$60 million for states in the Mississippi River and Ohio River Basins to support states' Nutrient Reduction Strategies and fight hypoxia.



Improving Water, Wastewater & Environmental Remediation

- Louisiana can take advantage of <u>WIFIA program loans</u> to help cities with their water and wastewater infrastructure needs.
- Louisiana is on track to receive \$371 million for the Clean
 Water State Revolving Fund program and Drinking Water State
 Revolving Fund.
- \$4.7 billion for programs to plug, remediate, and reclaim orphaned wells on federal, state, and tribal lands. In Louisiana, the Interstate Oil and Gas Compact Commission reports there are nearly 4,000 orphan wells. This funding will not only help remediate orphan wells onshore and in State waters but provide economic opportunity for oilfield services workers.
- \$150 million for the Delta Regional Authority.
- \$3.5 billion for Superfund site cleanups over five years, an increase in spending for remediation with a focus on projects of the greatest hazard to human health. The state cost share requirement is waived. Louisiana currently has 13 sites on the National Priorities List.

- \$1.5 Billion for Brownfields Grants. This funding will clean up and reinvest in properties complicated by the presence of hazardous substances or contaminants and prioritized by the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality.
 - \$1.2 billion is provided for the Brownfields competitive grants.
 - \$300 million has been dedicated for Brownfields categorical grants to support state-led Brownfields grants. There are no state cost share requirements for these dollars.

LOUISIANA WINS

CALCASIEU RIVER BRIDGE

Louisiana already received \$150 million to go towards replacing the I-10 Calcasieu River Bridge in Lake Charles. The I-10 Bridge is one of nine projects announced to receive money from the Fiscal Year 2022 MEGA Grant Awards. Louisiana received the third highest award in the nation. This amounts to 12.5 percent of the total first-round MEGA Grant funding for the Calcasieu River Bridge alone.

Intended funding for this project will replace the I-10 Bridge to increase capacity. The proposed bridge will be wider, with six lanes, shoulders and center barriers, a lower approach incline, increased overhead clearance, and improved interchanges.

PROJECT CYPRESS: LARGEST INFRASTRUCTURE AWARD IN THE U.S. GOES TO LOUISIANA

Louisiana is set to receive up to \$600 million in grant funding from the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) to plan and construct a Direct Air Capture (DAC) hub in the state, making it the largest single award from IIJA to date.

Project Cypress, to be located in southwest Louisiana, received an initial \$50 million to begin development of a regional DAC hub in August 2023. Once completed, the hub will capture more than one million tons of carbon dioxide (CO2) from the atmosphere annually and sequester the CO2 permanently deep underground.

Battelle will act as the DAC Hub owner in partnership with technology providers Climeworks Corporation and Heirloom Carbon Technologies, Inc. Project Cypress intends to rely on Gulf Coast Sequestration (GCS) for the offtake and geologic storage of captured atmospheric CO2. The owner of GCS, the Stream family of companies, is also supporting Project Cypress as the landowner and lessor of the host site in southwest Louisiana, and will provide land suitable for the construction, installation, commissioning, operation, and maintenance of the DAC facilities developed by Climeworks and Heirloom.

At its full value, the Project Cyprus award is the largest competitive grant award issued as a result of IIJA to date. The project is one of only two projects in the country that has the opportunity to claim the full grant value.

RECORD NUMBER OF ORPHAN WELLS PLUGGED IN LOUISIANA **BECAUSE OF INFRASTRUCTURE** LAW FUNDING

In just six and half months, 519 orphan or abandoned wells have been plugged in areas such as the Atchafalaya Basin and Northwest Louisiana. This is a monumental step in keeping our state clean and healthy. Since mid-January, Louisiana has plugged more than 10 percent of our state's orphan wells.

Before IIJA, Oilfield Site Restoration was never able to cap more than 239 wells in any given year. This is not a poor reflection on the state but rather a reality of financial constraints. The IIJA allocated \$47.4 million to Louisiana in Phase One for orphan well restoration, making Louisiana seventh in the nation for total Phase One funding. With the initial \$25 million received thus far, we have more than doubled the prior yearlong record in just half a year.

In total, Louisiana is expected to get \$111.4 million in funding from the IIJA for orphan wells.

With an estimated 4,605 orphaned wells in Louisiana, we still have a long way to go but the money is there to continue to build on this progress. We have created jobs, made cleaner places to live, and restored land that can be used for new economic opportunities.



LOUISIANA RECEIVES \$1.35 BILLION IN BROADBAND FUNDING

Louisiana was awarded \$1.3 billion in broadband funding to help provide access to high-speed internet across the state.

The funding comes from the BEAD program, which was authorized and appropriated at \$42.45 billion in IIJA. Given that Louisiana has approximately 1.3 percent of the total U.S. population, our state received two and a half times more funding for broadband—punching way above our weight.

More than 474,000 households are now receiving affordable highspeed internet due to IIJA.
